Triple R is excited about our Girl Scout Spring, 2010 Campout Weekends. The campouts include both one-night and two-night packages. We offer five weekends this spring and each include exciting adventures for your troop of scouts.

RESERVATIONS

Reservations are accepted by phone on a first come first served basis. After making a phone reservation, the first of two reservation forms is due in two weeks with a deposit of \$200.00. This "initial" reservation form confirms your phone reservation and secures it with your deposit. A "final" reservation form with your final count and **the balance of your fees is due three weeks prior to your arrival.**

FACILITIES

Lodging will be in our 12-14 bunk air-conditioned cabins. The two cabin areas are grouped around a central bathhouse. These rest rooms have hot showers as well as toilet and sink facilities. Troops must be willing to share cabin space with another troop as is needed and age appropriate. No girl scouts will be asked to sleep in a cabin without at least one adult chaperone from their troop. All meals will be served in our spacious air-conditioned lodge.

MONEY MATTERS

One Troop Leader with a troop of 12 or more scouts may come to camp for free. Final payment and final reservation forms are required three weeks prior to your arrival and delinquency may affect your schedule. The final reservation form will have the date due clearly printed on it. After we have received the final reservation form, the maximum allowance for cancellation is one person. Refunds will be made after the event.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

The Ranch provides alternate programming. **RAINY WEATHER DOES NOT CONSTITUTE REASON FOR CANCELLATION OF WEEKEND.**
